

# **RULE OF LIFE**

"Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing." -John 15:4-5

As we begin 2025, I am sure that many of you have made your New Year's resolutions, which can be helpful to launch you into the new year with goals and direction. As I've grown in my walk with Christ, I've come to realize that Jesus invites us to have different kinds of goals and that our direction in life includes Christ at the center. Jesus invites us to abide in him, to bear much fruit, which in regular language means having a regular rhythm or daily practice.

When we moved to Mayfield, one of the gifts we received was a lemon tree. We've had it now for about three years. It started off about a foot tall. We had to transplant it to a larger pot. A friend recommended we put it in front of the window in the winter. And this year, a gardener recommended we fertilize the tree. It has grown to be about four feet tall and this year is flowering for the first time. But, it took time to grow, and it took the wisdom of a community of people to help it grow.

This is true of our life with Christ. Our invitation at the start of the year is to root our life in Christ, keeping God at the center of our rhythm and purpose. There is tool called the *Rule of Life*, that can allow us to pray and plan for our growth in our life for the coming year.

This program, which began four years ago, has been a way to show appreciation and love to the teachers and staff at Emsizini. Funds from this program help cover fuel for teacher commuting costs, continuing education opportunities, and a modest yearend bonus to the teachers and staff for a job well done.
